## INTRODUCTION

**Since 2011, the Perry County Sheriff's Office has released a yearly report to show the activity within and conducted by the Office. This report is normally issued in late January or early February and covers the activity for the previous year.**

**On July 6<sup>th</sup> 2017, the Sheriff's Office adopted policy 344 Community Relations. Section 344.11 of this policy states, in part, "The Office should periodically publish statistical data and analysis regarding the office's operations."**

**It is with this in mind that we are issuing this Semi-Annual report for 2017. While not as in depth as our normal yearly final report, this report will give an idea of Office operations so far in 2017.**

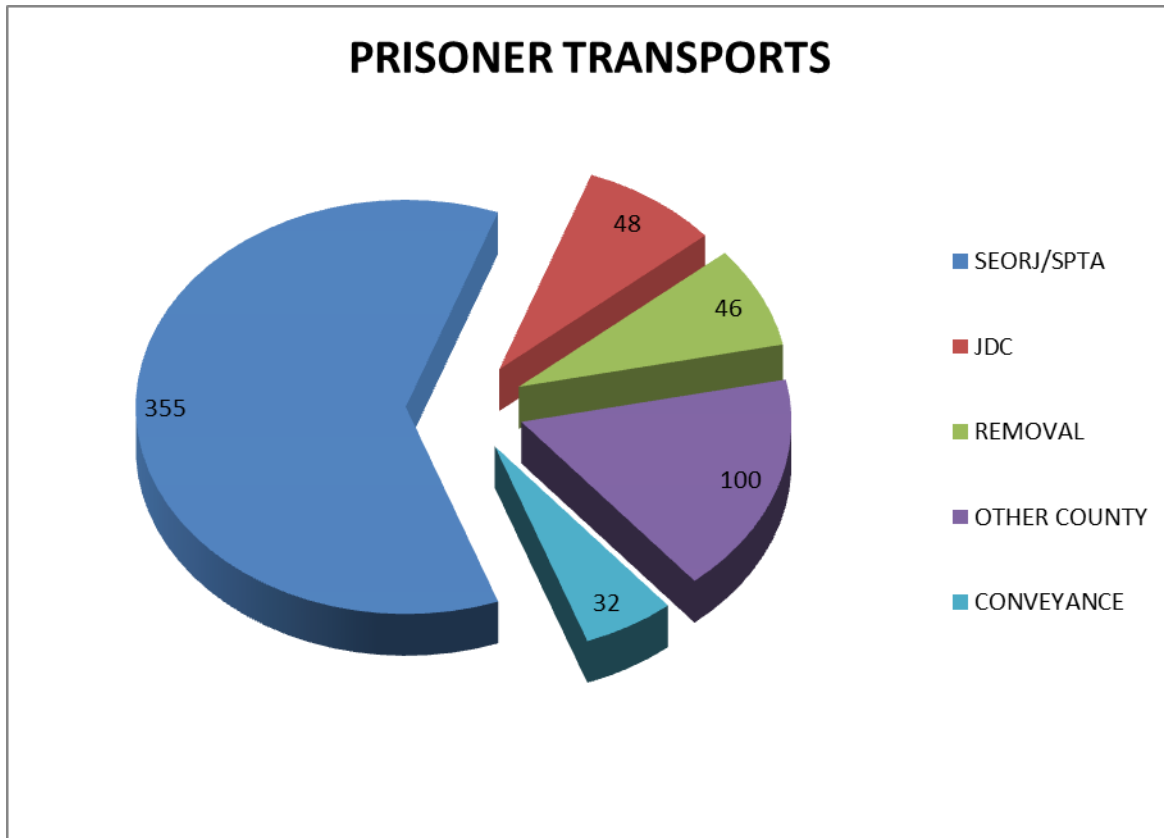
